Hearing of Oral Submissions

1. Purpose

To hear oral and consider written submissions.

2. Background

2.1 Written submissions

A total of 104 submissions have been received by the Greater Wellington Regional Council, which includes six late submissions (**attachment 1**).

2.2 Origin of submissions

The table below lists origins of each submitter on the plan. The trend shows that the majority of submissions (61.2%) were received from within Hutt City with Wellington City being the second major (14.6%) contributor in submissions.

2.3 Composition of submissions

The table below shows the number of submissions that have come from individuals, organisations (including community groups), local authorities (including community boards and ward committees) and government departments. The greatest number of submissions were received from individuals (61.2%) followed by those received from organisations (28.2%).
