

Notice of Official Results for the Wellington Regional Council's 2004 Elections

I give notice under section 86 of the Local Electoral Act 2001 of the official election results for the Wellington Regional Council. Two councillors, Rex KIRTON (Upper Hutt Constituency) and Chris TURVER (Kapiti Constituency) have previously been declared elected unopposed. This required eleven councillors to be elected from four constituencies in the Wellington region.
