1 Apologies

2 Declarations of conflicts of interest

3 Public participation

There was no public participation.

4 Process for the election of the Chair and Deputy Chair – Report 26.85

Lucas Stevenson, Democratic Services Advisor, spoke to the report.

Moved: Mayor Anita Baker / Darrin Apanui

That the Committee:

Considerations for the appointment of chairperson

- 1 Notes that the Committee resolved at its meeting on 5 December 2023 that:
 - a the Committee Chairperson will not be independent but will be drawn from the local government and iwi members of the Committee
 - b if the Committee Chairperson position is filled by a local government member, then the Committee Deputy Chairperson position shall be filled by an iwi member, and vice versa
 - c the iwi member being either the Chairperson or Deputy Chairperson will be remunerated for this position in addition to the current member remuneration, with the additional remuneration determined

by Greater Wellington Regional Council, as the Administering Authority

- d the Committee Chairperson and the Deputy Chairperson will operate as if they are “dual chairs”.
- 2 Agrees that the Committee Chairperson will not be independent but will be drawn from the local government and iwi members of the Committee.
- 3 Agrees that if the Committee Chairperson position is filled by a local government member, then the Deputy Chairperson position shall be filled by an iwi member, and vice versa.
- 4 Agrees that for the purpose of leading the business of the Committee, that the Chairperson and Deputy Chairperson will operate as if they are Co-Chairs.
- 5 Notes that the iwi member being either the Chairperson or Deputy Chairperson will be remunerated for this position in addition to the current member
- 6 Notes that the person nominated by the Committee to fill the role of Committee Chairperson is appointed by Greater Wellington Regional Council, as the Administering Authority, on the recommendation of the Committee.
- 7 Notes that the Chairperson and Deputy Chairperson hold office until the next triennial local government elections.

Election process

- 8 Adopts, pursuant to Schedule 7 of the Local Government Act 2002: Appointment by statutory voting system A.
- 9 Agrees that any voting that requires a resolution by ‘lot’ to exclude any person/s will use the procedure where candidates’ names (with the same number of votes) are placed in a container and the name of the person drawn out by an independent person is deemed the winner (i.e. elected, or not excluded from the next round).
- 10 Adopts the voting system and procedure outlined in recommendations 4 and 5 for the nomination of the Chairperson and appointment of the Deputy Chairperson.

The motion was **carried**.

4.1 Appointment of Chair

Lucas Stevenson advised that the Committee Agreement outlines the appointment of Chairperson. The Committee nominates a member for the Administering Authority to appoint. Lucas Stevenson called for nominations for the position of Chairperson of the Wellington Regional Leadership Committee.

Moved: Mayor Zee / Huia Puketapu

That the Committee recommends to Greater Wellington Regional Council to appoint Council Chair Daran Ponter as Chair of the Wellington Regional Leadership Committee.

Moved: Mayor Baker / Mayor Laban

That the Committee recommends to Greater Wellington Regional Council to appoint Mayor Andrew Little as Chair of the Wellington Regional Leadership Committee.

There were no further nominations.

Voting was done via show of hands, with eight votes for Council Chair Daran Ponter and four votes for Mayor Andrew Little.

Council Chair Daran Ponter was declared to be nominated as Chairperson for appointment by the Administering Authority.

4.2 Appointment of Deputy Chairperson

Lucas Stevenson called for nominations for the position of Deputy Chairperson of the Wellington Regional Leadership Committee.

Moved: Darrin Apanui / Council Chair Ponter

That the Committee appoints Helmut Modlik as Deputy Chair of the Wellington Regional Leadership Committee.

There being no further nominations, Helmut Modit was declared the Deputy Chairperson of the Wellington Regional Leadership Committee.
